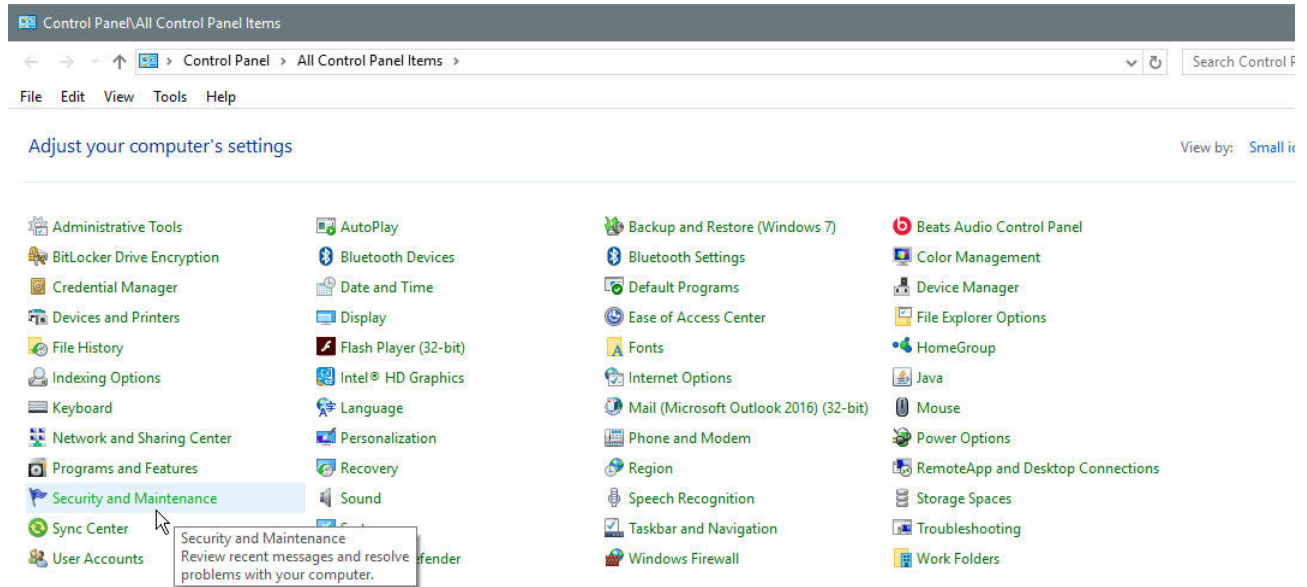


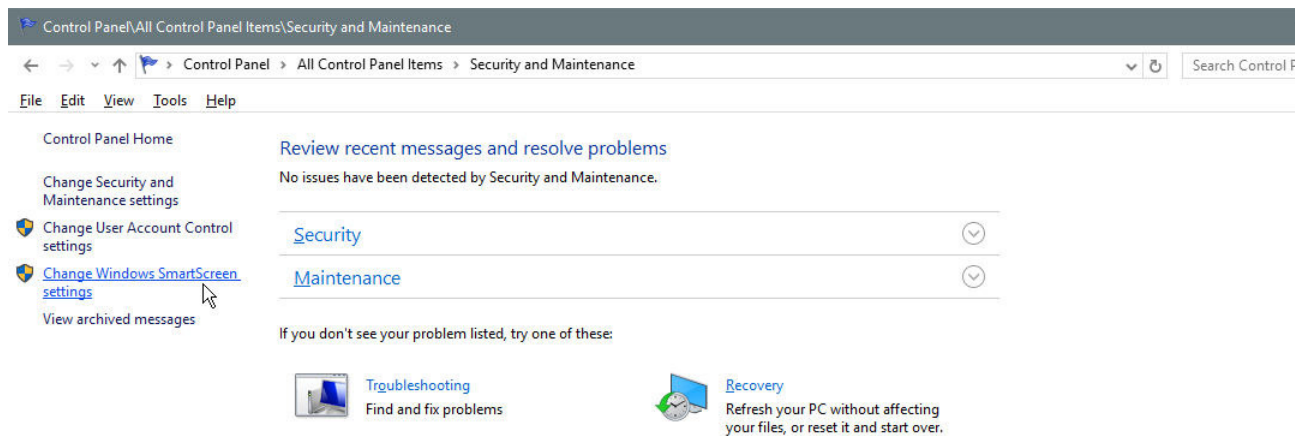
- When I double-click on the MPBD_win.exe I get a SmartScreen warning on Windows 10, what do I do?

Follow these steps to fix this issue (you'll need administrator privileges for these next steps):

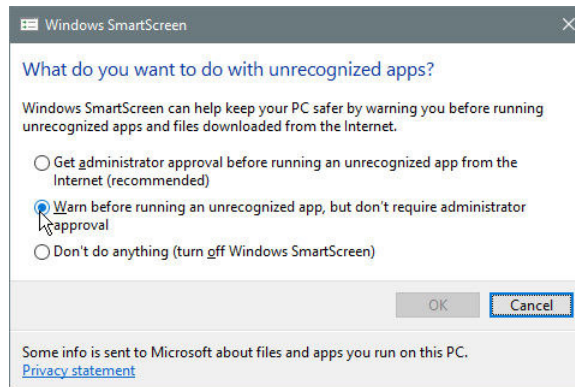
1. Open the Control Panel and click "Security and Maintenance"



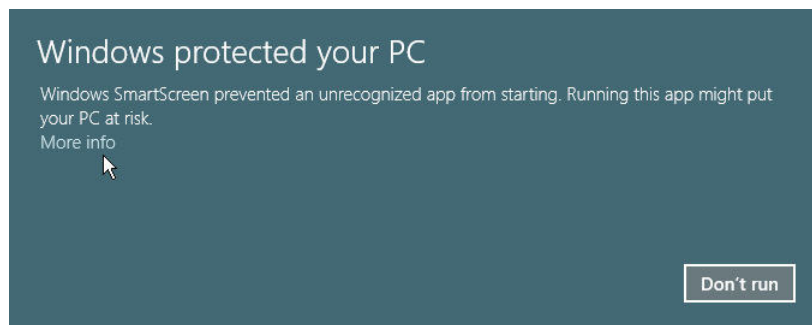
2. Click "Change Windows SmartScreen settings"



3. Click "Warn before running an unrecognized app..." radio button then click "OK".



4. Double-click the MPDB_win.exe and you'll see this SmartScreen prompt, click the "More info" text.



5. Click the "Run anyway" button. You only have to do this once and Windows will remember that this app is allowed. If you like, you can reset the SmartScreen protection level back to "Get administrator approval before running...".
